All funds raised at the auction will go towards the long-term project of digitising, cataloguing and exhibiting Bush's extensive archive of images, which are being cared for by Te Manawa Museum, with the support of the New Zealand Rugby Museum and the Bush family.



Peter Bush Mural

A special montage of Peter Bush's photos. From a distance, the mural has the NZ Rugby silver fern woven throughout the photos. Only two copies of the mural exist. One was on the walls on New Zealand Rugby House for several years, the other toured New Zealand with the "Hard on the Heels" exhibition circa 2011. This mural measures 355cm x 225cm (approx) and is valued at \$2,000.



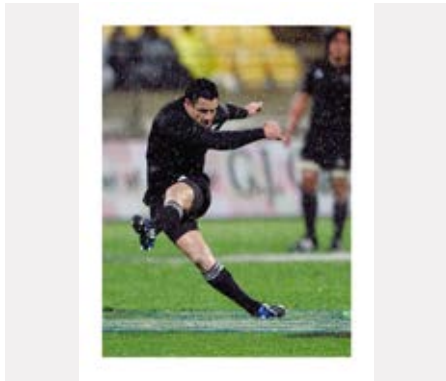
Cat A Tickets: Wellington Argentina v All Blacks

1924 - 1925 NZ Rugby Tour Scrapbook

Every member of the 1924-25 All Blacks touring party were presented with a large extremely well put together scrapbook at the end of the tour. This priceless example was the property of W. Dustin, one of the ten tour supporters. On gilt edged paper and enclosed with a black leather bound cover, these books are exceptional.



Signed Rugby Ball

One of three balls used in the 2011 World Cup semi final match between the All Blacks and Australia. Signed by Craig Joubert for Graham Mourie, this ball is valued at \$150. A crucial 20-6 victory over the Wallabies enabled the All Blacks to progress to the final and subsequently win the World Cup against France.



1924 Invincibles Framed Photograph

The 1924 Invincibles were unbeaten in 32 games on tour to the UK, France and Canada. One of the greatest All Blacks sides. Valued at \$150, this photo is a reproduction circa 1960 and was likely hung in a Hotel.



Peter Bush Label Pinot Noir & Blanc de Blanc

One bottle of Pinot Noir and one bottle of blanc de blanc beautifully packaged in a limited edition Peter Bush label. With labels featuring an epic shot of the All Blacks team photographed by Peter Bush himself, these bottles make enviable collector's items. Valued at \$120.
